

Coe College Teacher Education Program Progression and Benchmarks

- Enroll in Educational Foundations EDU 205 and one other education core course
- Work on fulfillment of college and Iowa general education requirements
- Receive satisfactory scores on the C-BASE (basic skills) test
- Begin professional portfolio (eportfolio)
- Start completing teaching major(s)
- Complete Dispositions checklist – completed by professor and self-review

Apply to Teacher Education Program

1. Complete application to Teacher Education Program
2. Minimum GPA 2.7 (Secondary Education: Minimum GPA 2.7 within major)
3. Receive satisfactory recommendation from all current professors
4. Receive satisfactory scores on the C-BASE (basic skills) test

- Complete Teacher Education Core Classes:
Educational Psychology, Practicum, Human Relations, Exceptional Learners
- Continue Dispositions checklists

Demonstrate satisfactory progress on all indicators in post-practicum review by Teacher Education Department Faculty

- Enroll in and satisfactory complete teaching methods courses:
 - Secondary – varies by teaching field
 - Elementary – Reading, Language Arts, Science, Math, Social Studies, plus two of the following four: Art, Music, Physical Education, Health
- Continue eportfolio development and Disposition checklists
- Start a credentials file with the Career Services Office

Apply to student teach. Deadlines:

- February 1st for fall student-teaching placement
- April 1st for spring student-teaching placement

STUDENT TEACH

- Apply for teaching license: Satisfactory recommendations from supervising instructor, co-operating teacher, and Coe Teacher Education Department
- Complete eportfolio and verify completion of all performance assessments
- Elementary Education: Receive satisfactory PRAXIS II test scores
