$$\text{Let } \mathbf{F}(x,y,z) = \frac{x}{x^2 + y^2 + z^2} \mathbf{i} + \frac{y}{x^2 + y^2 + z^2} \mathbf{j} + \frac{z}{x^2 + y^2 + z^2} \mathbf{k} .$$

1. Find $\text{div } \mathbf{F}$.

2. Find $\text{curl } \mathbf{F}$.
