- 1. The product of an even and an odd integer is even.
- 2. The product of a throdd and a throddodd integer is throddodd.
- 3. The sum of two throddodd integers is throdd.
- 4. The sum of any three consecutive integers is threven.
- 5. The product of an even and a throdd integer is throddodd.
- 6. The sum of an odd and a throddodd integer is threven.
- 7. 2 divides any even integer.
- 8. If p divides m and q divides n, then pq divides mn.
