## Quiz 6 Calculus 1 7/26/2005

Each problem is worth 5 points. Clear and complete justification is required for full credit.

1. A three-pack-a-day smoker trys improving his health by going for a run. He starts out fast, but slows down gradually before collapsing in a gasping heap along the roadside. His speed at various instants is given in the table below. Give a good lower bound estimate for the distance he covers in the first 60 seconds of his run.

| Time | Speed |
| ---: | :---: |
| 0 | $20 \mathrm{ft} / \mathrm{sec}$ |
| 15 | $16 \mathrm{ft} / \mathrm{sec}$ |
| 30 | $10 \mathrm{ft} / \mathrm{sec}$ |
| 45 | $6 \mathrm{ft} / \mathrm{sec}$ |
| 60 | $2 \mathrm{ft} / \mathrm{sec}$ |

2. Given the following profit estimates reported by the company FadDiets.Com, give a reasonable overestimate of the total profit the company can expect during the year2006.

| Quarter | Expected Profit |
| :--- | :---: |
| $10 / 2005$ | $\$ 5$ million/month |
| $1 / 2006$ | $\$ 7$ million/month |
| $4 / 2006$ | $\$ 4$ million/month |
| $7 / 2006$ | $\$ 2$ million/month |
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
