The three main teachings in China

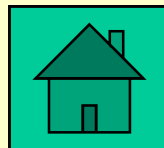

Dollar?

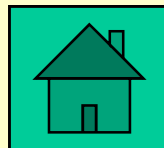
**You get about 33 of these

What is snake blood?

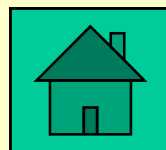
**A special ingredient added to

What is Bone script?

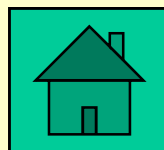
**The earliest form of

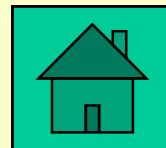

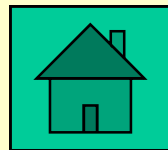

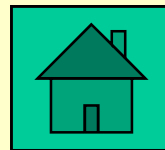

What is fruit?

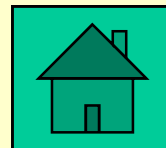
**A food group rarely used

What is the Chinese Opera?

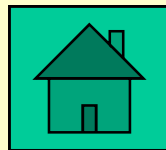
Where Jackie Chan got his start.





What is the Hong Kong Dollar?

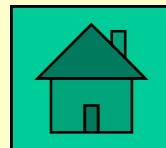
**The currency of Hong Kong,

What is Chinese?

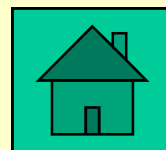
The most commonly spoken

What is Yum Cha?

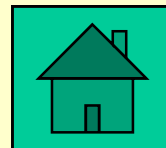
This cuisine, consisting of a series of small appetizer-like dishes, *a la carte*, first became popular among single men, and takes its name literally from the words for “drinking tea.”





What is face painting in Chinese Opera?

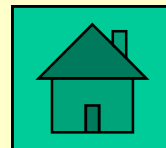
A technique that represents the personality of the character as well as the fate of the character
